Jaclyn Tyler, Vice President and Relationship Manager, was selected as a 2025 Community Service Award winner to recognize her work with the Cherokee County Child and Family Service Board. Tyler is Chairwoman of the Executive Board for the organization.

The Cherokee County Child and Family Service Board (CCCFSB) helps to ensure the appropriate services are provided to all abused, neglected, and at-risk children in Cherokee County. The group works closely with the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services. They offer monthly allowances to children in the foster care system, in addition to a quarterly clothing allowance and an annual Christmas party. They also host the Rainbow Room which is a 24/7 resource center located at the local Child Protective Services office. The Rainbow Room is stocked with clothing, school supplies, diapers, and much more to assist children who are victims of abuse or neglect.

In her leadership role, Tyler has continued to research ways to expand the Board's program offerings. They have been successful in expanding their ability to help combat food insecurity by providing additional funding to foster families during the summer months when meals are not available through the school system.

Tyler started her career with Austin Bank in 2009. She is a graduate of Jacksonville High School and Texas A&M Commerce. In addition, she has also completed the bank's Commercial and Consumer Lending School as well as Leadership I; the Jacksonville Leadership Institute; and the Dale Carnegie Leadership Training Program. Tyler and her husband, Jon, reside in Jacksonville where she also volunteers her time serving as treasurer for the Jacksonville Education Foundation; treasurer for Jacob's Well; and is a member of the Lions Club.
